# COVID-19 Weekly Update- Employee (Friday, October 22, 2021)

## Current COVID-19 Status (August 1, 2021 through 10:00 am Friday, October 22, 2021)

- <u>90</u> reports (includes positive cases, symptomatic individuals, close contacts, and potential exposures)- +8 from last week
- <u>24</u> confirmed positive cases- +1 from last week
- <u>6</u> individuals are currently in isolation or quarantine either on- or off-campus

## Garrett County COVID-19 Status (August 1, 2021 through 10:00 am Friday, October 22, 2021)

- Level of Community Transmission- High
- Case rate of 51.21 per 100,000
- Positivity Rate of 13.03% (state rate is 3.21%)
- Percentage of population (12+) fully vaccinated is 49.9%

### **Employee COVID Vaccination Survey**

President Biden issued an executive order in September requiring businesses with more than 100 employees to require all employees to be vaccinated against, or be tested weekly for, COVID-19. This will go into effect once the Occupation Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) issues the required regulations to implement the President's executive order.

# In order for the College to prepare, we are asking employees to complete a quick survey by Friday, October 29.

To access the survey:

- 1. Log into the <u>MyGarrettCollege</u> portal.
- 2. Select the "Employee Info" tab.
- 3. Under "Employee Information Links" select the "Employee COVID Vaccination Survey".
- 4. Complete the survey and submit!

NOTE: No additional information is needed at this time. Please do not send a copy of your vaccination record or email information about why you may not be vaccinated. If your status changes after you submit but before October 29<sup>th</sup>, you can submit a new response.



### Health and Safety Protocol Reminders:
